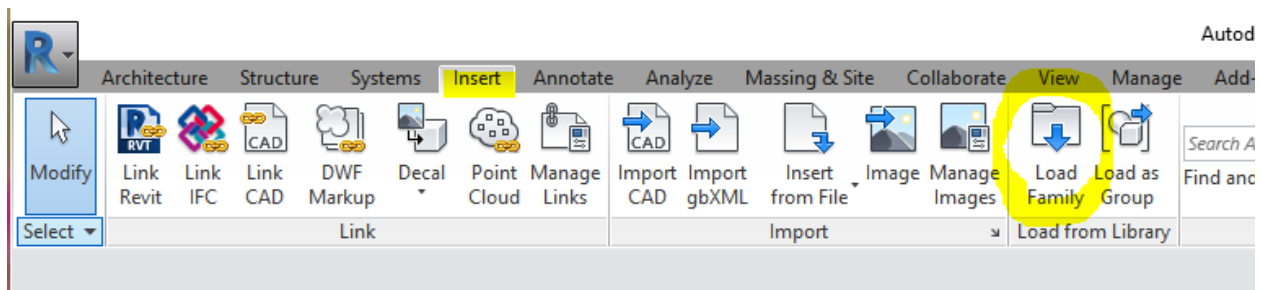


Thank you for downloading our Revit collection or library!

- *The text files*
 - Most of our products have standard sizing so don't forget to save the TXT file with the same name to the same location on your computer!
 - Some products that do not have standard sizing:
 - The Signature Modern series
 - Specialty shapes or Direct Glaze products
 - Custom sizing is available and the family can be adjusted after being loaded into your project
- *Material families*
 - Contain exterior color options which can be accessed with door or window Edit Type
- *Loading a family*
 - Load the family from your open Revit project (RVT)
 - Go to the Insert tab and select Load Family (image below)
 - Browse to the RFA file on your computer and "Open"
 - Select standard size/Type from the listing provided there was a text file associated with the family
- *Working in your project*
 - Once the family is your project, it will be located in the Project Browser in either the Doors or Windows category
 - Double-click the Type or drag and drop it into a wall, highlight it and Edit Type from the Properties screen
 - Adjust lite cut, finish, glazing, operation, configuration, casing, sill type, sizing...
 - Please check min/max sizing and assembly availability with your local rep or dealer



- Assembly disclaimer in Properties
 - Please note that assembly availability must be verified with your local rep
- Detail families
 - Native Revit detail families are available for Modern, skylights, Skycove and some Ultimate products
 - Look for a folder labeled Details in the Collection or Library ZIP
